  - include participants from at least two HWW consortial partner institutions
  - OR**
  - include participants from one HWW consortial partner institution and one of more of the following:
    - o Regional and Community Colleges
    - o Predominantly Minority Serving Institutions
    - o Historically Black Colleges and Universities
    - o Tribal Colleges and Universities
    - o Community organizations
- Proposals should include graduate students as collaborative research partners
- The PI must come from a discipline within the humanities and/or arts, but teams may comprise scholars from any discipline(s).
